

**Notes from the Public Question Time session at
the Parish Council Meeting – 14th July 2010**

- There were nine members of the public present.
- A resident from Main Street complained about the bus stopping outside her house to let passengers off. She stated that she had not bought a house with a bus stop outside. Another member of the public said that the very kind driver sometimes dropped her off in Main Street, but at the end of Court Farm Lane. After much chat, which also concerned the way the bus reverses in Little Beckford, the PC chairman asked if the public could take down the bus number and the PC would then write to the bus company regarding the issues in Main Street and Little Beckford.
- The (then) Flood Warden asked if the minutes from the last meeting could be changed, as they stated that he had objected to there being more than one Flood Warden. He explained that he had not objected, but that he required a clarification from the PC about the role of Flood Warden as the PC seemed to be confused over the role of Flood Warden and that of Chairmen of the Flood Groups. Three councillors said they also thought the Flood Warden had objected. A member of the public suggested that a note be attached to the next minutes saying that there had been a misunderstanding – the PC chairman refused the suggestion.
- It was suggested by the Parish Clerk, that any questions put forward during Public Question Time should be submitted at least 2 days before the meeting to give the councillors a chance to research and make sure the question is answered fully.
